West of Scotland Archery Association are pleased to invite you to our outdoor championship for 2026 hosted by Glasgow Archers and supported by Commonwealth Games Glasgow 2026 Festival in association with Glasgow Life.

Date and Timings	Sunday 2 nd August 2026. Field opens 8.30am, registration 9.30am. Inspection from 10.00am followed by assembly at 10.15am. Two ends of practice and shooting will commence after assembly. All times are subject to change but will be no earlier than stated times.
Venue	Whitecraigs Rugby Club 199-201 Aurs Road, Newton Mearns, Glasgow, G77 6PX.
Entry and Fee	Entry fee is £25 for seniors and 50+/ £20 for U21, U18 and U16, U14. Rounds	<p>WA900: 90 arrows (30@60m, 30@50m, 30@40m)</p> <p>Junior WA900: 90 arrows (30@40m, 30@30m, 30 @20m)</p> <p>Junior round for U16, U14. Seniors may shoot but not qualify for medals.</p> <p>All bow types and age groups on 122cm faces.</p>
Age Groups	50+, senior, U21, U18, U16, U14 and Novice for ages 21 and above.
Categories	<p>Barebow, junior ages may be combined into one U21 category depending on numbers. An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category. (e.g. if they turned 15 in a calendar year, they can compete in an U16 category, but they cannot if they turn 16 in the year). An archer may compete in the 50+ division when the competition takes place in the year of their 50th birthday and thereafter.</p> <p>Open/Female Category: Only individuals who are assigned as female at birth may compete in a female category. Any gender may compete in the open category.</p>

Archery GB Cards	You must show your AGB card at registration. Archers who cannot show a card or receipt will not be permitted to shoot.
Dress Regulations	Archery GB dress regulations apply. Please comply with the dress code until after the presentations.

Judges	TBC
Awards	Medals awarded to top 3 archers in each category, including visitors. Plaques only for top WoSAA members.
Drug Testing	Archers may, at any time, be liable for drug testing and if competitors are approached to give samples they must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Junior entries must be signed by a parent or guardian, giving consent for a drug test to be permitted if sought.
Photography	Provisions of the SAA Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy: Anyone wishing to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and sign the permission slip at registration. Photographers are reminded that images must not be used on the internet without the permission of those pictured (or, in the case of under 18s, their parents). Archery GB /SAA/ West of Scotland Archery Association may take general pictures of the event which may be used to report on or promote future events. If you do not wish to be photographed, please inform the Tournament Organiser.
Targets	A mixture of layered foam and Damage bosses will be used on H frames.
